Dr. Norige's Recent Trip to Maine Leading UCONN Dental Students Opens Eyes to Significant Health Concerns.

One of Dr. Norige's goals each time he leads a mission trip is to help his students to think outside of the box (or outside the mouth in their case!). It may surprise you how few people (some physicians and dentists included) think of the mouth, and of oral health, of having anything to do with the rest of the body.

As you may know, Dr. Norige recommends having your resting blood pressure, pulse, and body temperature checked each time you visit the office. Each of these painless to check vitals can give clues to a greater concern

During clinic hours each patient seen by Dr. Norige and his UCONN Dental Students was given the recommendation that they should have their blood pressure checked before care was given.

In less than one week four patients discovered they were suffering from hypertension. Hypertension frequently leads to heart attack or stroke.

Those patients were prompted to see their primary care physicians for immediate follow up, hoping to prevent a heart attack or stroke that hypertension often precedes.
